**Palo Pinto County – June 12, 2025** – Atmos Energy will perform routine maintenance resulting in the safe removal of natural gas on June 12, 2025, from approximately 6 a.m. to 6:30 a.m. at 1161 W Cedar St. in Gordon, TX. Atmos Energy remains focused on its vision to be the safest provider of natural gas services, and this system modernization work demonstrates a continued investment in safety, innovation, environmental sustainability, and our communities.

Residents in the area may hear a noise and the scent of mercaptan, a harmless odorant that gives natural gas its “rotten egg” smell, may be present during the operation.
