

PUBLIC NOTICE

Surface Water Monitoring and Reporting Violation

The City of Gordon water system (PWS ID TX1820007) has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements established by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems that treat surface water and/or groundwater under the direct influence of surface water are required to submit monthly operating reports containing operational data for the water provided to their customers.

The City of Gordon failed to timely submit the required **Surface Water Monthly Operating Report (SWMOR)** for **February 2026**.

This violation occurred during the monitoring period of:

February 1, 2026 through February 28, 2026

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe. Although the required monitoring report was not submitted on time, there is **no indication that the drinking water posed a risk to public health**. However, because the required report was submitted late, TCEQ could not verify compliance with all monitoring and reporting requirements during that reporting period.

The City of Gordon has taken the following corrective actions to address this issue:

- The February 2026 Surface Water Monthly Operating Report has been submitted to TCEQ.
- The City has reviewed its reporting procedures to ensure future monthly operating reports are submitted by the required deadline.
- Additional administrative tracking measures and calendar reminders have been implemented to prevent future late submissions.
- Staff has been reminded of all TCEQ reporting deadlines and compliance requirements.
